I am writing to you to thank you for your continued support with our recent changes and expectations at Vega College, we have been impressed by the start many of our students have made and how they have adapted to the changes. In our college, learning is a priority and we are working hard to give your child the best chances to achieve their GCSE's and future aspirations.

We are still experiencing some concerns with some students using their mobile phones during learning time. All students have access to their mobile phones at both break and lunchtime because we feel that this is appropriate in a college environment for young adults. We do not allow mobile phone usage during learning time, for all the right reasons, we prioritise learning, work and develop respectful relationships and we create a safe culture where students thrive.

In promoting our standards, staff will give daily reminders in learning time to your child about the expectations of mobile phones. We ask that you support us by reinforcing these expectations with your child. You will be contacted by our pastoral team if your child fails to comply to these expectations and disrupts theirs and others learning. Further consequences can be applied by your child's school if required to ensure Vega College is thriving provision for our young people.

As we head into half term, I would like to take this opportunity to say a thank you to Mrs Davis who has worked hard and stepped in as Interim Head, and also welcome Mrs Galloway who going forward has been appointed Vega Colleges Educational and Pastoral Lead, while being supported by Miss Proctor who has been appointed as Director of School Improvement and Inclusion.

Students have been working on their employability skills, focusing on speaking.

Work Placements:

TEACHING AND LEARNING

This half term students have been taught all core subjects with a focus on our new curriculum, this has been designed in collaboration with all mainstream settings that we work with to ensure full personalised coverage of the core GCSE subjects.
