Skills Builder:

This half term we have introduced Personal Development sessions and our first focus has been financial management. Students have enjoyed learning about different bank accounts, debt management, the UK tax system and renting and buying property. All students have earned a Short Course ASDAN Certificate in Personal Finance.

Work Placements:

We have two of our students starting work placements after half term with Refurnish, they will be helping to fix and restore old furniture giving it a new lease of life.

We also have a student starting at a guinea pig sanctuary and another student hopefully starting on a farm.



TEACHING AND LEARNING

This half terms topics are based on the work of Dorothy and William Wordsworth for year 10 and World War Two for year 11. We have studied diaries and journals from both time periods along with poetry, scientific discoveries and maths linked to the outdoors and war. Last week we researched and took part in class discussion to mark Holocaust Memorial Day in the morning followed by a trip to Danum Gallery to look at their tribute and war displays.

This week we will be visiting South Yorkshire Air Museum to look at what planes were used during war time. This links into our topic but specifically to a poem we are analysing called Kamikaze by Beatrice Garland, which is about a Japanese soldier from World War Two.
