Skills Builder:

After the success of our trips to the Aircraft Museum and Potteric Carr, we have arranged to visit Doncaster Wool Market. These excursions offer a great opportunity for us to practise our speaking skills in line with our Skills Builder targets.

We have one Year 10 student who has started a placement this term in the construction industry, working on a site that is building bespoke houses. We have also had numerous students visit Edlington Hill top Centre with a few students starting work placements there in various roles after Easter.



TEACHING AND LEARNING
